Sunday June 21st

Top 4 teams from Pool play will go into Championship bracket and lower 5 teams will play in 3rd place bracket. Game times for Sunday are 9, 12, 3 & 6pm.

Rules and Regulations

- 1) **Each team is responsible to provide 1 new game ball and 1 good back up ball per game played.**
- 2) Coin flip will determine home team each game.
- 3) Each game will have a 2 hour and 25 minute time limit. No new inning will start after 2 hours 15 minutes. No time limit for the Championship game.
- 4) If two teams tie after the time limit, the game will revert back to the last complete inning where there is no tie. If there is still a tie, it will be decided by coin flip.
- 5) **Courtesy runners may be used for pitcher and/or catcher at any time but must be used with two outs.** Please have the courtesy runner ready. Courtesy runner is the last recorded out.
- 6) Please have your kids hustling on/off the field.
- 7) All Junior Baseball Organization game rules apply.
- 8) Ten-run rule is in affect.
- 9) Infield may be taken before the first game of each day only and prior to the Championship game if time allows.
- 10) **It is the responsibility of the coaches to make sure extra players are chasing and returning foul balls.**
- 11) Pitchers are limited to a maximum of 9 innings for the weekend. One pitch thrown constitutes one inning.
- 12) After round-robin play, rankings will be broken according to:
 - a. Wins – Losses
 - b. Runs Allowed
 - c. If tied: Head to Head (if applicable)
 - d. Run differential (Runs scored vs. runs allowed)
 - e. Coin Flip (if still tied after all of the above)
